

Fall Testing Information for Seniors

SAT (Class of 2021)

Due to the changes in schooling last spring and the subsequent cancellation of the Colorado School Day SAT and PSAT-10, College Board and CDE (Colorado Department of Education) are offering a **free** school-based SAT for seniors.

SAT (Colorado School Day administration)

- **WHO:** Seniors (Class of 2021)
- **WHERE:** Pine Creek High School (in-person, in-building)
- **WHEN:** Wednesday, September 23, 2020
 - Testing begins promptly at 7:45 a.m.
 - **All classes for all grade levels will not be held on Wed., Sept. 23rd due to the SAT test administration for seniors.**
 - Buses will run at normal time in the morning and will depart PCHS at 12:30 p.m.
 - Note: Students taking the SAT with Essay or who have an accommodation of extended time will need to make their own transportation arrangements.
- **DETAILS:**
 - Students do not need to register.
 - There is no fee for the SAT test.
 - Students that registered for the SAT with Essay in the spring are automatically registered to take the SAT with Essay at this administration.
 - Only seniors participating in the SAT administration will be in the building on test day; this will allow for social distancing and approximately 10-12 students per classroom for testing.
 - The SAT for seniors is optional and not required for any student. If you do not want to take the SAT, please opt-out of the test by emailing the School Assessment Coordinator (T.J. Airhart) at teresa.airhart@asd20.org.
