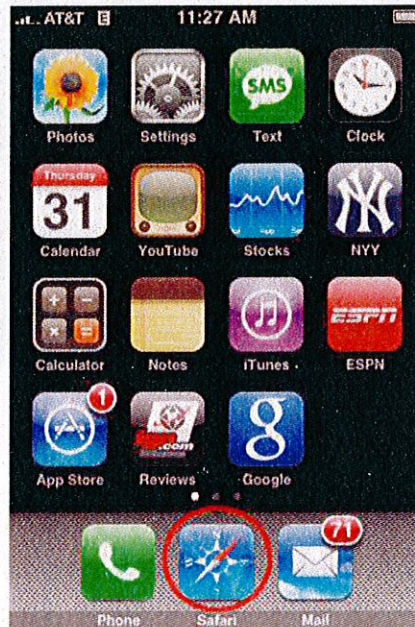


How to Add Home Screen Icons in Safari for the iPhone

The iPhone Home Screen contains icons which allow you to easily navigate your device's many applications and features. The iPhone's Safari browser gives you the ability to add Home Screen icons which automatically open your favorite Web pages. This tutorial shows you how to create these icons in just a few easy steps.

Open Your Safari Browser

First, open your Safari browser by tapping on the Safari icon, normally located on your iPhone Home Screen.



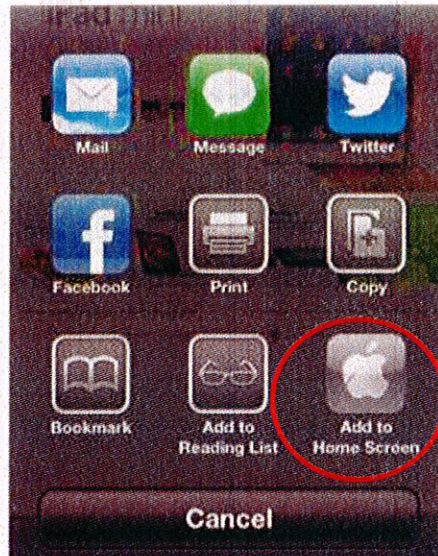
The Share Button

Your Safari browser window should now be displayed on your iPhone. Navigate to the Web page that you wish to add as a Home Screen icon. Once the desired page has finished loading, tap on the *Share* button located at the bottom of your screen.



Safari Menu

A menu should now be displayed on top of your Safari browser window. Select the choice labeled Add to Home Screen.



Add to Home

The Add to Home screen should now be displayed. In the example above, notice the field containing the following text: Web Browsers. This text is editable and can be changed to whatever you desire. It is important, as this is the title which will be displayed on the iPhone's Home Screen. Once you are done, select the Add button in the top right corner.
