## Early Graduation Process (Mid Year)

**STEP 1: DUE DATE:** No Later than September 1<sup>st</sup> of graduation year.

Student and Parent/Guardian meet with grade level counselor to discuss student's plan to meet graduation requirements. This includes checking current graduation status, plans to take additional courses and meet CDE ELA and Math requirements.

⇒ **COMPLETE Early Graduation Contract and Graduation plan matrix. Must be signed by parent/guardian, student, counselor and principal.**

**STEP 2: DUE DATE:** On or before the last day of Semester 1

⇒ **Obtain Early Grad checkout form from Counseling Secretary. Complete the Check-Out Procedures in numerical order:**

1. Return laptop/case/charger/cord
2. Return all books
3. Obtain signatures from all teachers
4. Obtain signature from Creek Café
5. Obtain signature from College and Career for completion of Naviance Survey
6. Obtain signature from Bookkeeper
7. Submit your completed form to Counseling Secretary

**STEP 3: Check for Senior Events/Graduation Information**

If you plan to continue to participate in PCHS events during Semester 2, please check your Infinite Campus account for updated emails. It is recommended that you add your personal student email to your IC account. This Week at the Creek events and any other important senior events will be sent via email. It will be the student's responsibility to check the website and/or emails for any senior announcements (grad practice, grad day show time, etc.)
